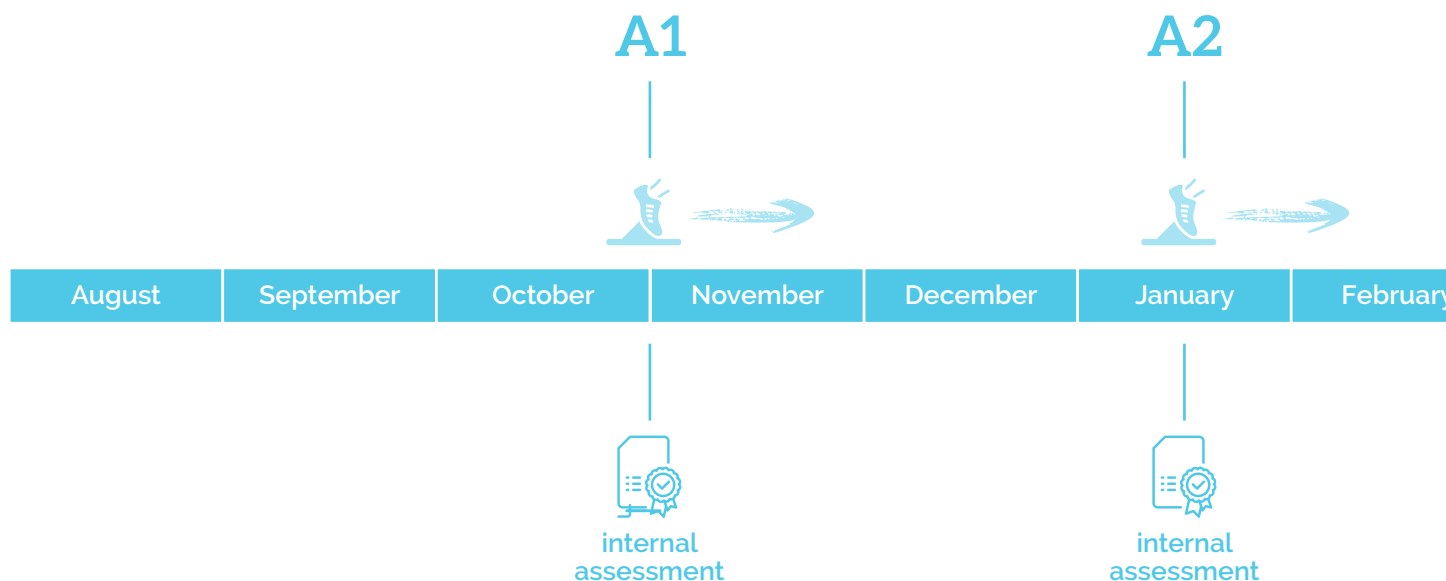


Our language school is deliberately not just about learning the language itself. Just as important is the idea of cultural exchange and the global understanding that our students gain from it.

Step by step.

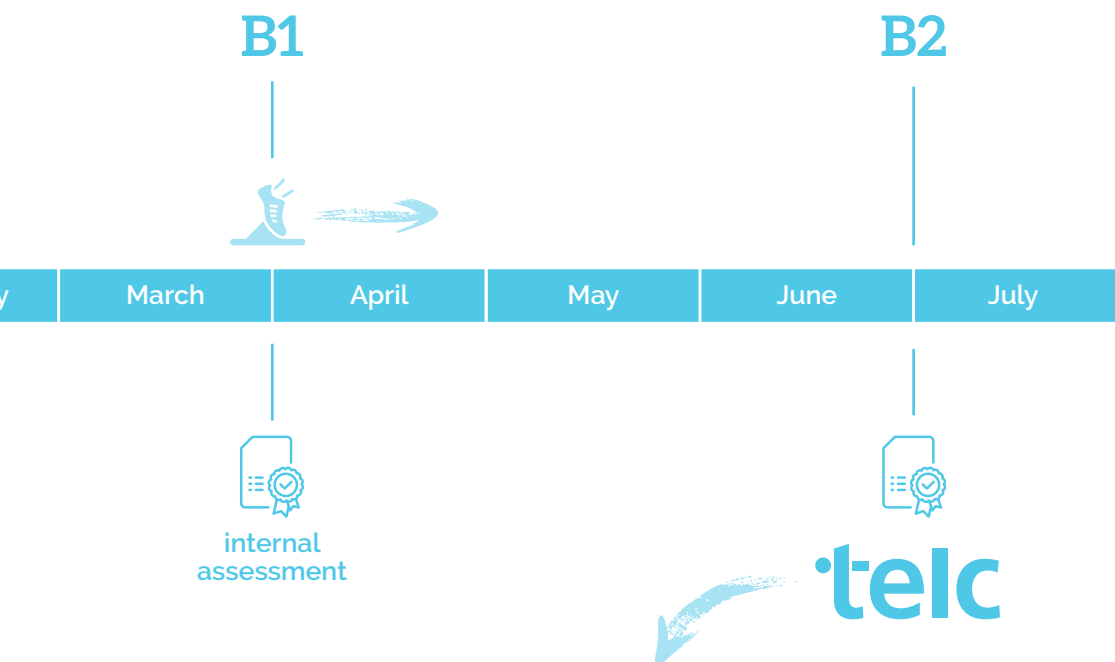
Learning new languages often comes with challenges. That's why we take you by the hand and guide you step by step from A0 to B2 in just one year!



In our language school, we accompany you on your journey - **step by step and at your own pace**. Our program is designed so that you can progress from a complete beginner (A0) to an advanced language user (B2) in just one year. Whether you are just starting out or already have some prior knowledge, **the entry points are staggered throughout the year**.

With a clear learning plan and the support of experienced teachers, you can rely on a comprehensive education that helps you achieve your desired language level. Of course, our courses cover all essential language skills: **listening, speaking, reading, and writing**. At the same time, we promote your intercultural understanding and prepare you—connected with our regular school operations—for everyday and professional language situations.

We conduct internal assessments for intermediate steps, and the **final qualification (B2) is confirmed through an official "telc" certificate, which qualifies you to attend the upper secondary school in Germany**.

From day one, they not only learn German as a foreign language but also attend subjects like English, Mathematics, and Physical Education—together with German students in the same class.

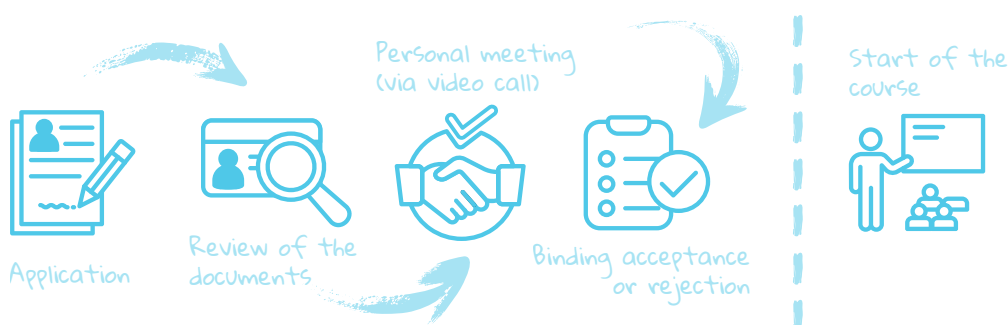
This significantly eases the later transition into regular classes, as the young people become familiar with the German school routine in this way.

Our language school: Your bridge to the German education system.

It is a pleasure to accompany you on your journey towards a German educational qualification. Your first step towards this is the German language! And here's how it works so simply:



Registration for our in-house language school is done through the **International Office**, which is happy to **assist you with any questions regarding the registration process, visa issues, or the teaching program**.

Our German classes for beginners at **level 'A0'** **start after the summer holidays each year**. However, **enrollment in the language school is possible all year-round**. If you wish to join us during the ongoing school year, we will ensure that your language level matches that of the class at the respective start date.

If you choose our language school, we will need the following documents from you via E-Mail:

- A copy of your last two school reports or grade summaries, translated into German or English
- Your CV in German or English
- Your motivation letter ("why are you applying to us?") in German or English
- Language certificates, if available
- A copy of your passport or residence permit

After **successfully reviewing your documents**, we would, of course, like to get to know you personally and invite you to a **video call**.

If all requirements are met on both sides, you will receive your **binding acceptance or rejection**. In the case of acceptance, our International Office will promptly contact you to exchange all further necessary information regarding your school start at Schloss Heessen and to support you if needed.

To ensure that you receive all important information from a single source, we have a dedicated admissions office for our international students.

The head of the office is Ms. Schleking. You will also encounter her in your daily life, as she is your direct contact person and will assist you with all your small and big organizational questions during your time at Schloss Heessen.
