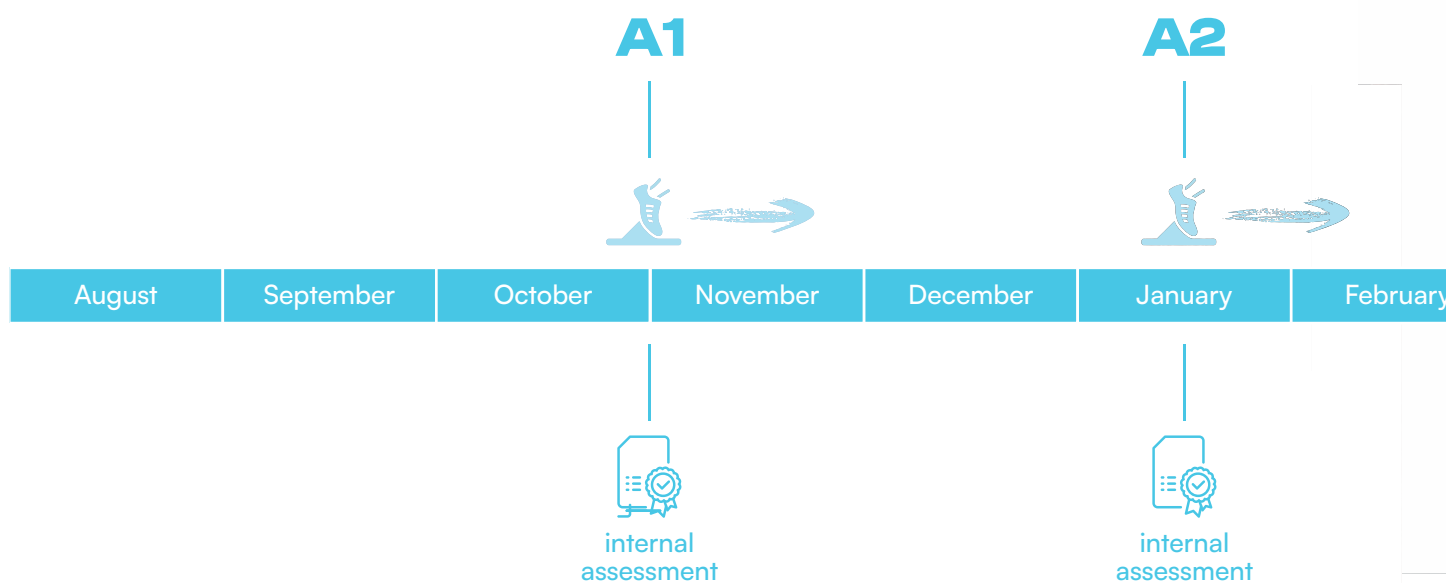

Step by step.

Learning new languages often comes with challenges. That's why we take you by the hand and guide you **step by step from A0 to B2 in just one year!**



In our language school, we accompany you on your journey - **step by step and at your own pace**. Our program is designed so that you can progress from a complete beginner (A0) to an advanced language user (B2) in just one year. Whether you are just starting out or already have some prior knowledge, **the entry points are staggered throughout the year**.

With a clear learning plan and the support of experienced teachers, you can rely on a comprehensive education that helps you achieve your desired language level. Of course, our courses cover all essential language skills: **listening, speaking, reading, and writing**. At the same time, we promote your intercultural understanding and prepare you—connected with our regular school operations—for everyday and professional language situations.



We conduct internal assessments for intermediate levels, and the **final qualification (B2) is confirmed through an official “telc” certificate, which qualifies you to attend the upper secondary school in Germany.**
